It does NOT contain amplified or recorded sound, or rigged lighting

SET INFORMATION

Venue Size Requirements

An Imaginary Life is presented in found spaces.

It adapts to the space it is presented in.

Ideally there is space for the performers about 8m wide and 6m depth, with room for audience to be seated on chairs at the same level, curved around the performance. We are happy to discuss your space with you in more detail.

The show suits audiences of 40-80, depending on the location.

The space needs a solid sense of acoustics.

The set is a 2.5m rattan rug, on which the musician and instruments sit, and one small floodlight that is positioned DSC.

The show travels with these items.

It requires 1x GPO to run, plus extension cable.

The performers enter the performance space from wherever they need to.

LIGHTING INFORMATION

An Imaginary Life utilises no rigged lighting.

It travels with one small floodlight

STAGE MANAGEMENT COMMUNICATIONS

An Imaginary Life is not run by a stage manager.

We require Front of House clearance communicated in some way.

AUDIO INFORMATION

There is no amplified or recorded sound in *An Imaginary Life*.

We prefer no house music played in the performance space before or after the show.

We travel with a series of percussion instruments that are played by the musician.

COSTUME INFORMATION

We will require the use of a washing machine.

DRESSING ROOM INFORMATION

AN IMAGINARY LIFE requires one dressing room, where possible, given the found performance location.

We require access to drinking water (tap is fine).

PROPS INFORMAITON

We will provide all the props and consumables required for the show.

The Presenter is required to supply the following

- All consumables (such as gaffa tape etc) as required
- Cleaning equipment (vacuum, and or broom and mop)
- First aid kit including instant ice packs accessible from backstage

Access to venue is needed 60 minutes prior to the show time.

FREIGHT/ ACCESS

The show travels light.

Set and costume packs into a van/luggage for air travel.

2x additional bags should be booked for percussion instruments

RISK MANAGEMENT

A show risk assessment will be provided to the presenter.

ACCOMODATION

The Presenter is to provide a single-room minimum of three and half star accommodation for each member of the touring party, as per the Live Performance Australia Award 2020.

For stays longer than one week, accommodation with cooking facilities is preferred.

GROUND TRANSPORT

If the venue is over 15 minutes walking distance, we will require ground transport.
