Technical Specifications

General Info

Screen Scene Carnival is a cinema/movies themed circus show. The show references various movie classics such as Men In Black, Jurassic Park, Mission Impossible, Beauty and the Beast and more. Run time for the show is 55-60 mins with no interval.



Venue Reqs

The show can be performed in a few different venues such as town halls but works best in theatres (ideally a black box).

Stage Area: Ideal dimensions are 8m x 6m of stage space. Some adaptations can always be possible so if your venue is close to these dimensions please do still get in touch.

Stage Floor: Flat, we will need a flat stage to perform acrobatics.

Height: Ideal height from is 5.5m-6m clearance above the stage.

Set: No set pieces or scene installation required for this show.

Show Info

Show length: 60 mins, no interval

Number of Shows: 6 shows per week, double show days possible (but not every day). No shows on bump in/tech days.

Touring Company: 5 artists and 1 tech

Lighting Info

Should be able to adapt to most standard venue lighting rigs, there are no crazy lighting states as part of the show.

Audio Info

The show runs off a Qlab file from a laptop, access to the PA system would be great. Our MC/host will also need a wireless handheld microphone for the show.

Bump In/Tech

At least 4 hours required for bump in and tech/plotting lights will be required for this show.
